Thank you to all those who have shown their support over this tricky period, and especially the vocal support we received in the last game against Chalfont St Peter, which really spurred the boys on. Founded in 1878, [Burnham Football Club](#) is the second oldest club Buckinghamshire. We played in the early years, with considerable success, in various leagues, before joining the Great Western Combination in 1948.

We moved to the Wycombe Combination in 1964 and then spent one season (1970/71) in the Reading Combination. In 1971 the club was elected to the Hellenic League. Winning both the Premier Division and League Cup in 1975/76. We were also twice beaten finalists in the League Cup too.

In 1977 the club were elected to the Athenian League and were twice runners-up before the league folded in 1984.

We competed in the London Spartan League in 1984/85. Winning both the Premier Division title and the League Cup.

The summer of 1985 brought about the amalgamation of the football club with Hillingdon Borough FC, who had lost their ground and were about to fold.

We played in the Southern League as Burnham & Hillingdon FC and reverted back to the former name of Burnham FC in 1987.

Season 1994/95 saw us finish bottom. Resulting in relegation to the Hellenic League.

After 3 seasons in the Hellenic League, finishing fifth, third and again third in 1998/99. the club won both the Premier Division title and the League Cup. Therefore, gaining promotion back to the Southern Football League where we have played ever since.

The 2006/07 season saw us achieve our highest league position. Finishing 3rd and thus qualifying for the end of season Promotion Play-Off semi final. Unfortunately losing to the eventual winners – Swindon Supermarine.

The 2012-2013 season was, without doubt, the most successful in the football clubs history. The First Team won the Evo Stik League Southern Division One Central (Southern League) championship. Earning promotion to the newly sponsored Calor League Premier Division (Southern League), while our Reserves won the UHLSPORT Hellenic League Division Two East championship at the first time of asking. Earning promotion to Division One East where they came up against the First Teams of many of the previous seasons opposition.

.CUP COMPETITION HISTORY

In cup competitions Burnham reached the Quarter Final of the FA Vase in 1977/78 and then went one better in reaching the Semi Final in 1982/83. Losing 4-2 over two legs to Halesowen Town. The clubs record attendance of 2400 was achieved in the home leg.

We have twice reached the Third Qualifying round of the FA Cup and in 2005/06 we reached the First Round Proper for the first time ever, before losing at home to Aldershot Town.

In the F.A.Trophy we reached the Fourth Round (the last 16) in 1999/2000. Before losing to Scarborough in a replay after a credible 1-1 draw at The Gore. In the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup we reached the Semi Final twice before losing on both occasions to Chesham United.

AND NOW... 2021

Burnham FC now play in the Cherry Red Records Combined Counties [Premier League North](#).

The renamed 1878 stadium and its facilities have undergone a major refurbishment programme over the last 12 months. Providing the board with the chance to achieve one of their key objectives of building closer links with local clubs and the local community.

In particular [Burnham Juniors](#) now enjoy the opportunity of both playing matches and training on the new football pitch together with other local football clubs, including [Chalvey Sports FC](#) who will play their home games for the 2021/22 season here, and [Britwell FC](#) who will also play some Friday night home games on the new pitch.

F.A. Cup Edgware 2 Boreham Wood 2

The Football League Scouts are watching Edgware with interest.

Following a great win over Southern League Dunstable in the previous round, Edgware (no 'Town' during this time) were drawn at home to local rivals Boreham Wood as they attempted to make further progress in the F.A. Cup.

In the Kingsmead Athenian League Edgware were also going well and had led the table in mid-September. Three young players were bringing in the scouts from Football League sides as Edgware's results began to draw attention, they were goalkeeper Dave Beasant and forwards Martin Sperrin and Brian Stein.

Our opponents, Boreham Wood were at the time in the Premier Division of the Isthmian League and a close match was forecast. Unfortunately Beasant missed the game through injury but Edgware had an excellent understudy in the ever-dependable Mick Gavigan.

The match itself was an even contest, level 1-1 at half time, and finishing 2-2 with Dempsey and Sperrin the goalscorers. This was a very good result for Edgware but by the time of the next home game, against Chertsey, Sperrin and Stein had been transferred to Luton Town. Although they were not under contract Luton agreed to make a donation to Edgware and an arrangement was made to send a team to The White Lion at a future date.

It was Martin Sperrin who made his full debut first for the Hatters, but once Stein got into the first team he became a fixture for many years giving the Bedfordshire club excellent service with over 400 appearances. Brian went on to win a full England cap (against France in 1984) and scored twice as Luton beat Arsenal in the 1988 League Cup Final.

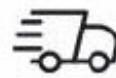

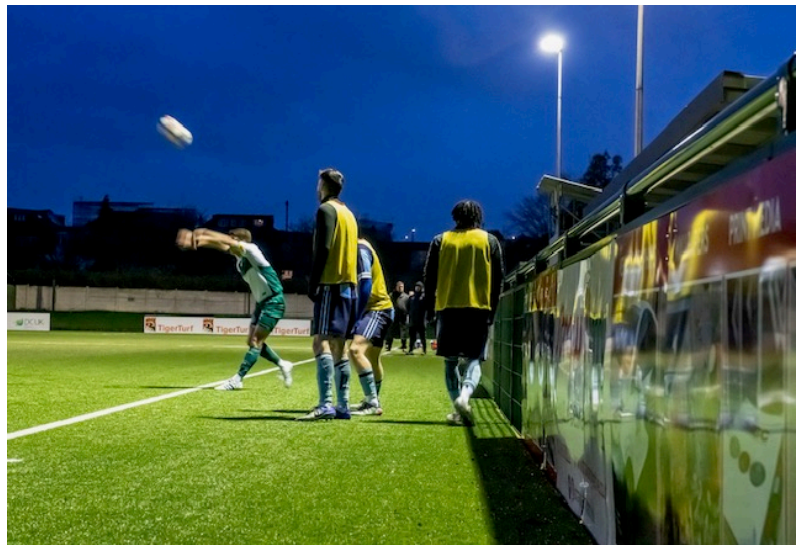

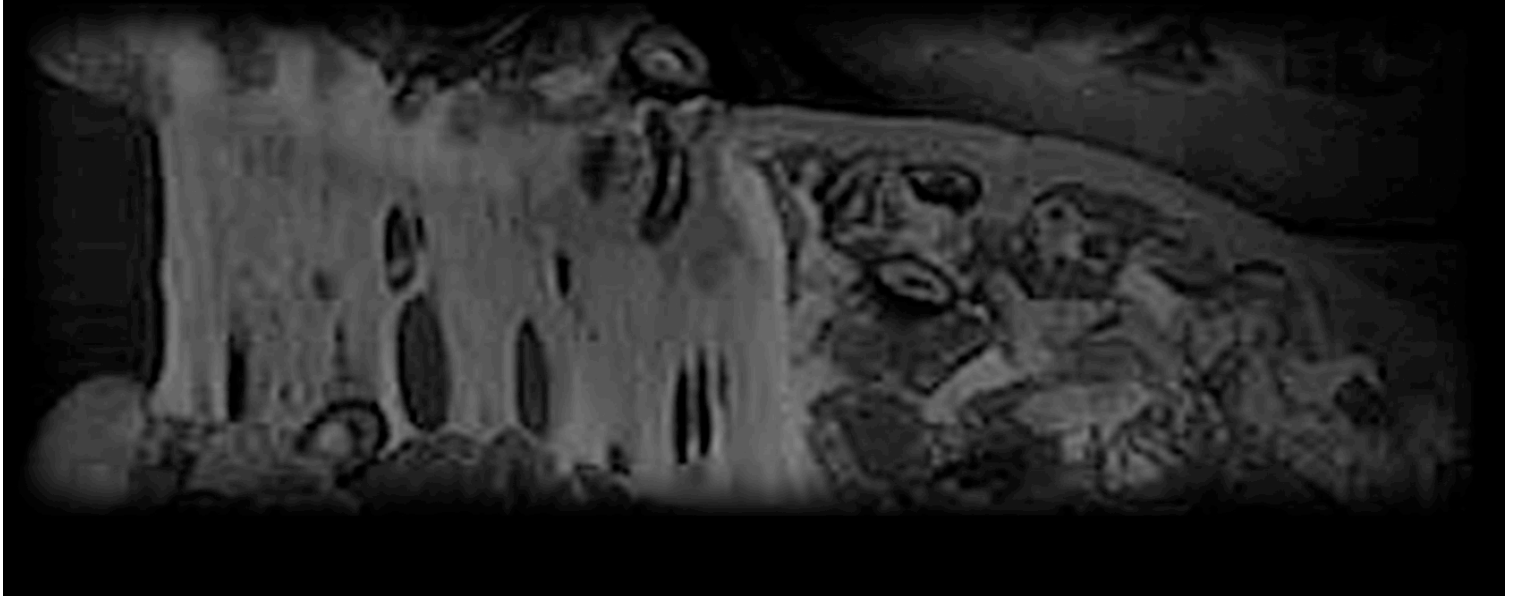
