A WORD WITH THE BOSS

Good afternoon and welcome back to Silver Jubilee Park for first home game since 14th October. It feels like the majority of our football has been played away this season, with 7 home games so far in all competitions and 11 away.

In our three away games since our last home game against Virginia Water, I have been extremely pleased with the attitude and performance levels of the team. We do not have the reward we believe we should have, but results have started to turn after a difficult period of defeats. The 2-1 loss to Virginia Water was not a fair reflection of a game we dominated throughout. We then went to Cobham in the FA Vase and produced another exceptional display, but again lost 2-1. It is worrying when you lose games even when you are playing so well. However, with the group of players we have, we have stayed calm and the last two tough away games against both Milton and Wembley have been 2-2 draws, where once again we performed well and really could have had more. The main thing is that we have stopped the run of defeats and picked up some much-needed points.

In past seasons we have experienced difficult runs and at times we felt big changes were required, and new blood was needed. In this situation it is quite different, where we just need small tweaks and a bit of confidence. The upcoming run of games looks very tricky on paper, but football is played on the pitch, and we will go into each game ready to compete and work hard for a positive result.

On Saturday against Wembley, the group showed fantastic spirit to come back into the game after going two-nil down against the run of play. In the end we were pushing and pushing for a winner, but just ran out of time. I must mention the terrific away support we received, the best we have had this season. This helped to propel us to get back into the game.

It is a long season and although results have not gone our way so far, we are really pleased with the group we have put together and the performances. We feel our results have not reflected the quality of the group we have. We are working extremely hard to put it right. In football you go through difficult moments but it builds character and experience and we will come out better for it.

Today we face Rayners Lane, who sit top of the division and remain favourites for promotion. In the previous game we lost 4-2, with goals conceded at key moments in an otherwise close affair. They have gone from strength to strength since then and have an experienced, quality squad. They will be expected to win so it is up to us to change the narrative. That will take conviction in our principles and the whole squad putting in strong individual displays.

RAYNERS LANE CLUB HISTORY

Rayners Lane FC was originally founded in Harrow, Middlesex, in 1933 and spent their formative years playing in local football. By the early 1960's they had joined the Spartan League, a tenth spot finish in 1966-67 their highest placing. In 1978-79 they had joined the Hellenic League and they were crowned Division 1 champions on goal difference in 1982-83, earning promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division where they stayed for eleven seasons before lack of floodlights saw the club returned to Division 1. Two seasons in Hellenic Division 1 were followed by two seasons in the Middlesex League before they joined the Chiltonian League Premier Division in 1998-99.

The Chiltonian and Hellenic Leagues merged in 2000-01 and Rayners Lane found themselves in Division 1 East which they won in 2012-13. However, they were denied promotion due to ground grading issues and stayed in Division 1 until the 2017-18 season when they moved to the Spartan South Midlands Division 1. That summer work began on installing a 3G playing surface along with a new club house and the Tithe Farm Sports & Social Club was eventually opened in October 2019. A year later long time club stalwart Tony Pratt was recognized by the FA with Volunteer Of The Year Award for over 50 years of service, a fine achievement for both the club and Tony.

The club remained in the Spartan South Midlands League until the 2021-22 campaign when restructuring by the FA saw them moved over to the Combined Counties League Division 1. A fourth place finish saw them reach the Play-Offs where they lost in the semi-final to eventual winners Wallingford Town. The following season saw them again finish fourth which resulted in another Play-Off spot where this time they overcame London Samurai Rovers in the semi-final and then Langley in the final to earn promotion. They also beat British Airways FC to win the Middlesex Premier Cup to chalk up a first ever League and Cup double.

2023-24 sees Rayners Lane competing in the Combined Counties Premier Division North under the stewardship of Gary Meakin and Wes Daly as they attempt to bring Step 4 football to The Lane for the first time ever

JACK SMITH - Goalkeeper

Jack made over 100 appearances for Hayes & Yeading United and has also spent time with the likes of Hemel Hempstead Town and Dunstable Town

IVAN ATKINS – Defender

Ivan moved to Rayners Lane from Banstead Athletic for whom he played a dozen games in the 2022-23 season.

MARCO CORREIA – Defender

Belgian born defender who joined The Lane in September 2023. Formerly with Windsor and Beaconsfield Town.

MANNY FOLARIN – Defender

Hailing from Nepal, Manny was a part of Leighton Towns' 2022/23 Spartan South Midlands Premier title winners squad. Has also played for the likes of St. Albans City.

KEANO ROBINSON – Defender

Keano played over 100 games for Hayes & Yeading United and has also played for the likes of Beaconsfield Town, Herne Bay, Hendon and Hanwell Town.

OLIVER SPRAGUE – Defender

A former Player of the Season at Hendon and Beaconsfield Town, Olly has also appeared for the likes of Welling and St. Albans as well as having played in Cyprus with Aspis Pyla F.C.

CALLUM WEBB – Defender

A former pro at Millwall, Callum has also turned out for the likes of Slough Town and Kingstonian as well as making over 100 appearances for Beaconsfield Town.

HAMILTON ANTONIO – Midfield

Hamilton joined The Lane at the start of the 2023-24 season and has previously played for the likes of Walton Casuals, Herne Bay and Hendon.

RIO CONNELL – Midfield

Young, hotly tipped winger who has gained non league experience with Barnet.

ZAINE GANGADEEN – Midfield

Another experienced campaigner who has appeared for the likes of Hadley, Wembley, Uxbridge, North Greenford United and Hanwell Town.

HASSAN JALLOH – Midfield

Experienced attacking midfielder who joined from Hayes & Yeading United for whom he made over 120 appearances and scored nearly 50 goals. Has also played for the likes of Dulwich Hamlet and Herne Bay.

FRANK KEITA – Midfield

A recent signing from Hendon (for whom he made over 60 appearances), attack minded Frank has also played for the likes of Hayes & Yeading United, Boreham Wood and Harrow Borough.

AARON MINHAS – Midfield

A full international for the Panjab National side, Aaron also played over 100 games for Beaconsfield Town and won 'Players Player Of The Year' when they won the 2017/18 championship. Joins from Uxbridge.

TROY PEREZ-DUAH – Midfield

Young central midfielder who has played for Walsall's Under 23 side. Has also had experience at Salisbury and Chesham United.

KYEL REID – Midfield

An ex-pro with over 300 League games for the likes of West Ham United, Colchester United, Charlton Athletic and Bradford City, Kyel has played and won at Wembley. He also scored the goal that secured promotion to the Premiership during his time at Wolves.

DANIEL UCHECHI – Midfield

A former U23 player for Nigeria and an ex-pro with both Aberdeen and Sheffield Wednesday. Daniel has also played for the likes of Hampton & Richmond Borough, Cray Wanderers, Hornchurch and Hendon.

NATHAN WEBB – Midfield

Vastly experienced older brother of Callum. Nathan has had a long career in Non League football, playing for the likes of Slough Town, Hayes & Yeading United, Kingstonian, Beaconsfield Town and Binfield.

ELLIOTT BUCHANNAN – Forward

Much travelled and experienced centre forward who has been a pro at Stevenage and also turned out for the likes of Newport County and Farnborough. Joined Rayners from Step 3 side Beaconsfield Town and scored on his debut.

BRADLEY BUBB – Forward

Bradley has 10 full international caps for Grenada and has also appeared in the Football League with Aldershot Town. Other clubs he has featured for include Farnborough, Woking, Ebbsfleet United and Wealdstone as well as Belgian side Royal Antwerp.

ALEX CATHLINE - Forward

Experienced target man who has previously played and scored for the likes of Beaconsfield Town, Chalfont St. Peter, Hertford Town and Egham Town.

GARY MEAKIN – Manager

Gary played for the likes of Hendon, Doncaster Rovers and Northwood before injury curtailed his playing career. He had his first managers role aged 26 at Hillingdon Borough and since then has managed Northwood, Wingate & Finchley, Burnham and Egham Town. He led Beaconsfield Town to the Southern League South-East Division title in 2017-18 and successfully established them as a Step 3 club.

WES DALY – Assistant Manager

Wes played well over 500 senior games and was a professional at both QPR and Raith Rovers. He played a major part in AFC Wimbledon's rise up the Non League ladder and also played for the likes of Bromley, Maidenhead United, Basingstoke Town, Egham Town and Beaconsfield Town.

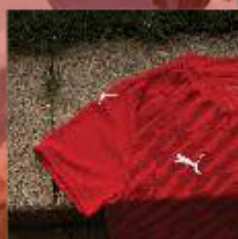

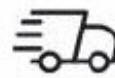

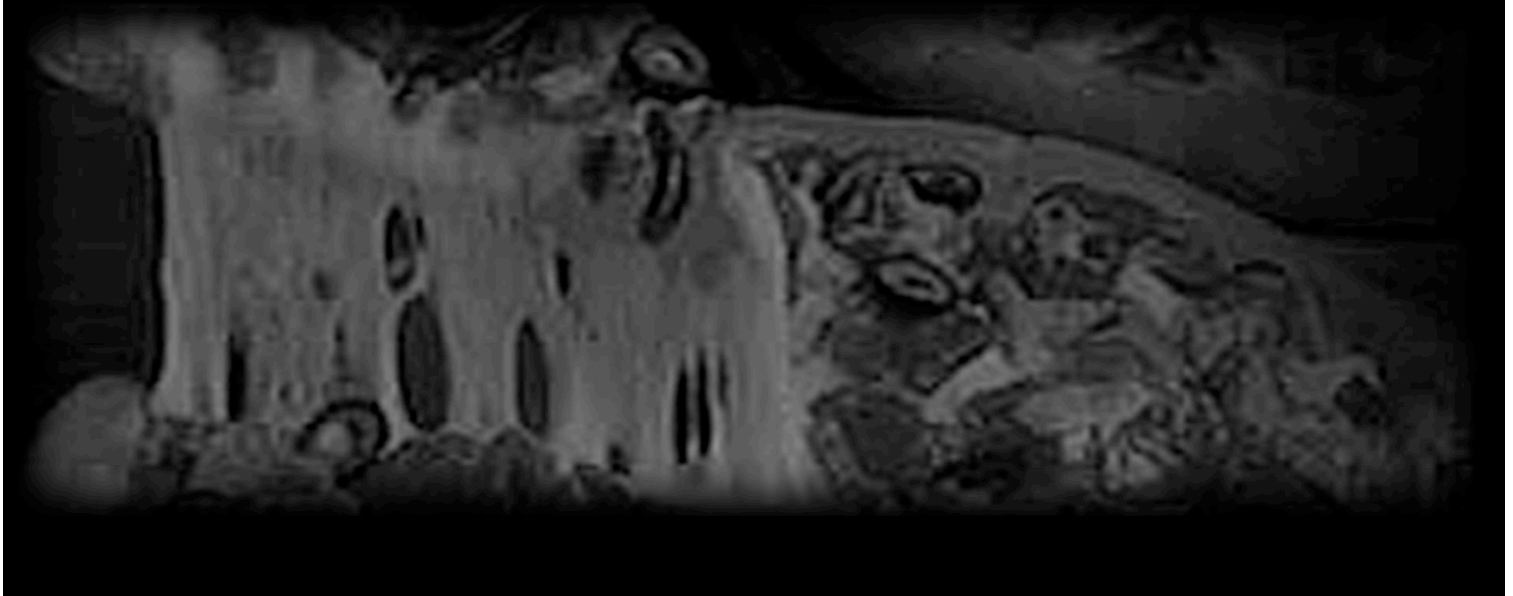
